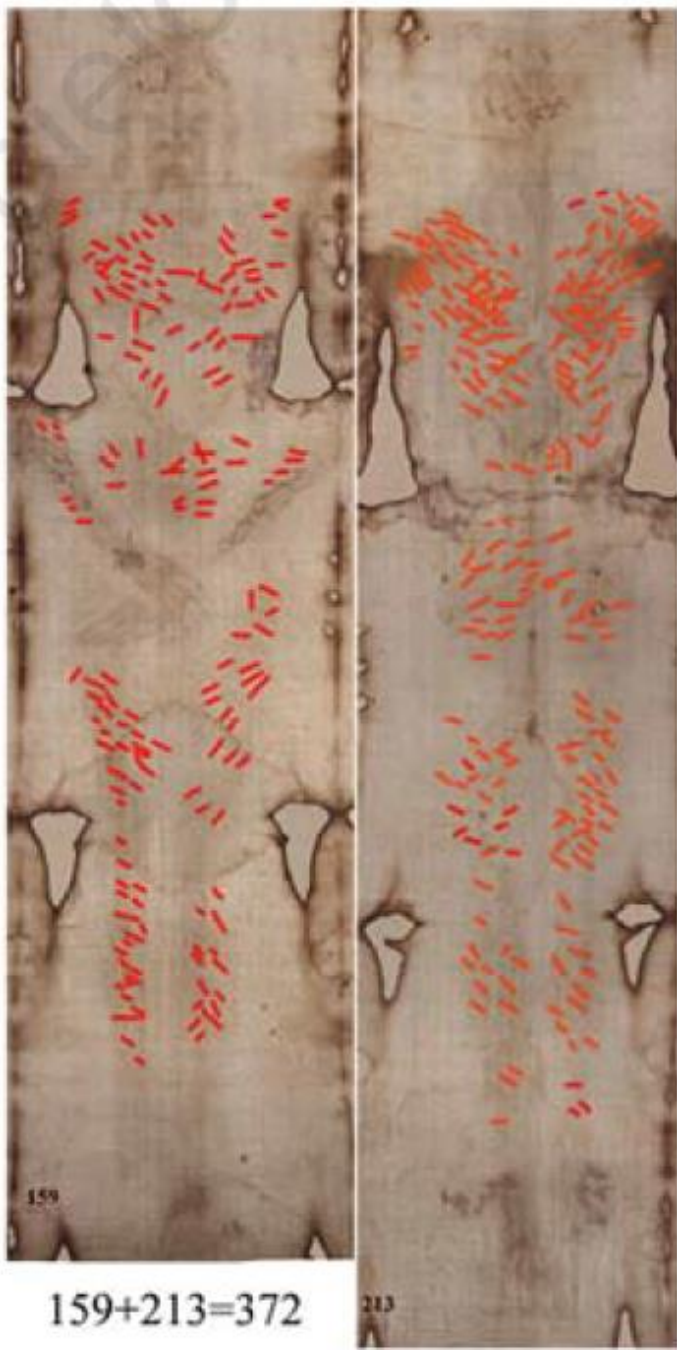


Figure 1. The most evident bloodstains relative to scourge marks, evidenced in red.

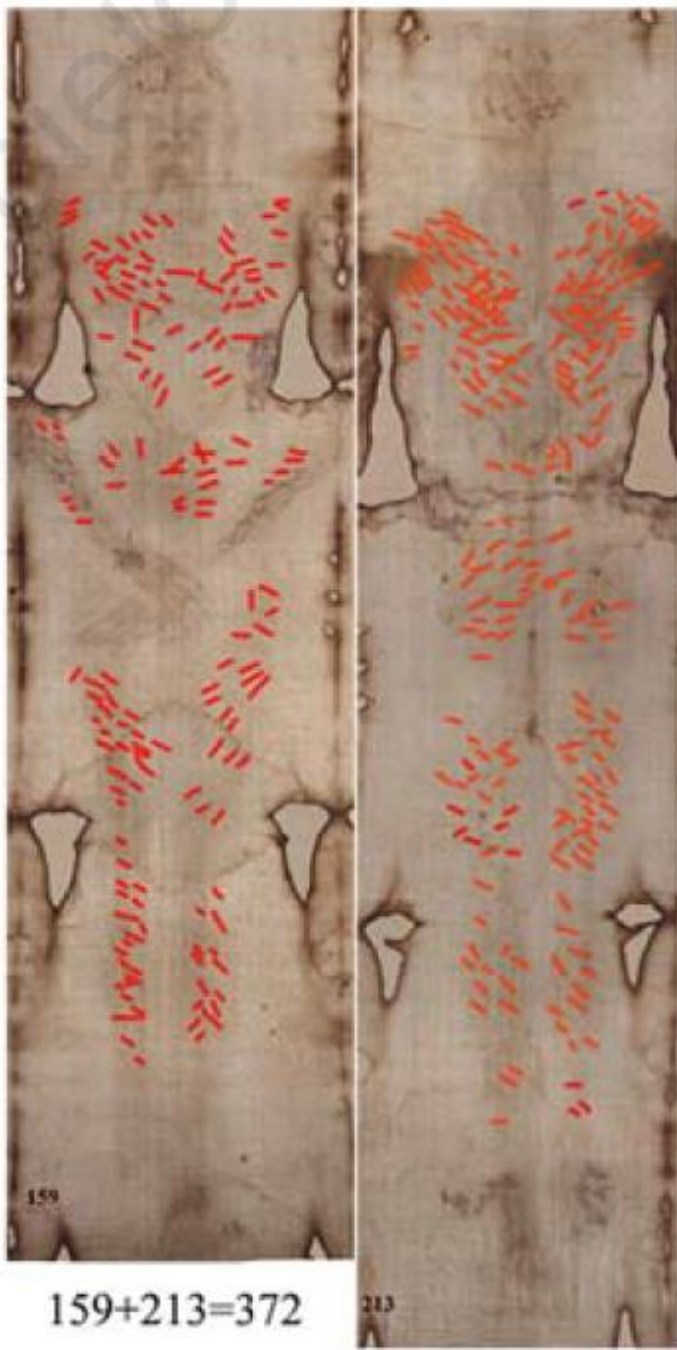
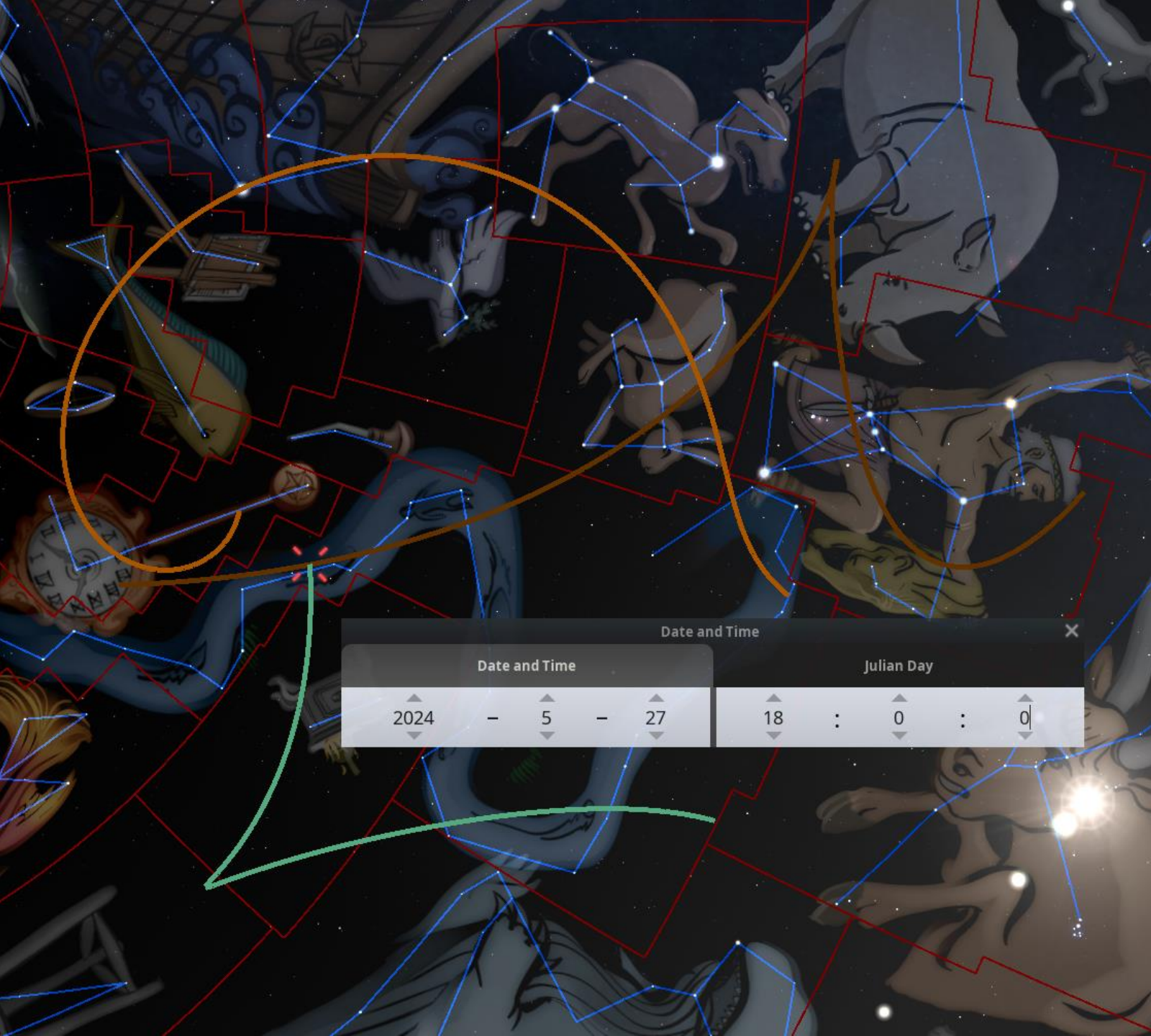


Figure 1. The most evident bloodstains relative to scourge marks, evidenced in red.

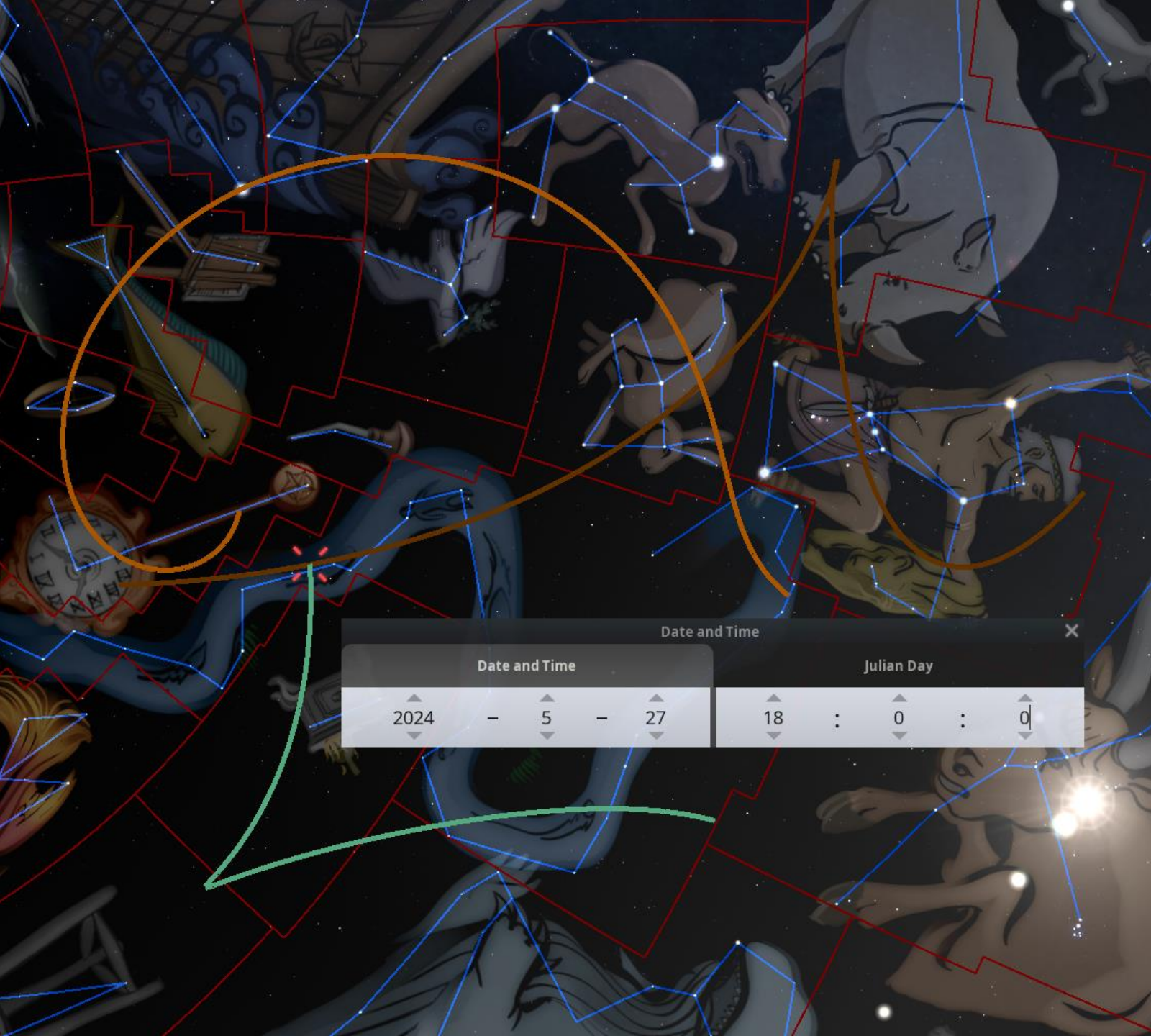
